

**FINAL STATEMENT**  
**OF THE FIRST MEETING OF THE INTERNATIONAL**  
**ADVISORY COUNCIL OF RESERVE**  
**OFFICERS ORGANIZATIONS**

15 June 2011,  
Russian Federation, Moscow

We, participants of the first meeting of the International Advisory Council of Reserve Officers Organizations, defined goals, objectives and main areas of our cooperation, in this connection inform the world public, that we are seeking projects implementation and arrangement of joint events on multilateral and bilateral basis, for solving issues of common interest.

Our cooperation do not imply any political activity whatsoever and is not intended to interfere in domestic affairs of neither participants of the International Advisory Council of Reserve Officers Organizations nor other public organizations and countries, and shall be carried out in compliance with generally accepted rules of international law.

We intend to contribute to:

- development of friendly and charitable attitude to veterans, military pensioners on principles of spirituality and compassion;
- promotion of principles of justice, mutual respect and friendship within the youths to their moral education, promotion of healthy way of living, involving young people in fitness and sport;
- enhancement of cultural, intellectual and business connections between countries by ways of public diplomacy;
- arranging for historic and educational international trips and other activities;
- arranging for events on the occasion of anniversaries and commemoration dates;

- sharing information through printed and electronic media resources of the International consultative Council of organizations of reserve officers;
- cooperation in other areas multilaterally and bilaterally.
